The Brook Trout Survey Project is a collaborative effort that began in 2011 with the Maine Council of Trout Unlimited (METU), Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife (MDIFW) and Maine Audubon (MA). The goal is to recruit volunteers to identify previously-undocumented wild brook trout populations in remote Maine ponds and coastal streams. The information collected by volunteer anglers will be verified by biologists and used to help inform future fisheries management decisions. Volunteer anglers will be in the field beginning in May and continuing through September of 2019 to gather data on ponds in western and northern Maine and coastal streams from southern Maine to Lubec.
